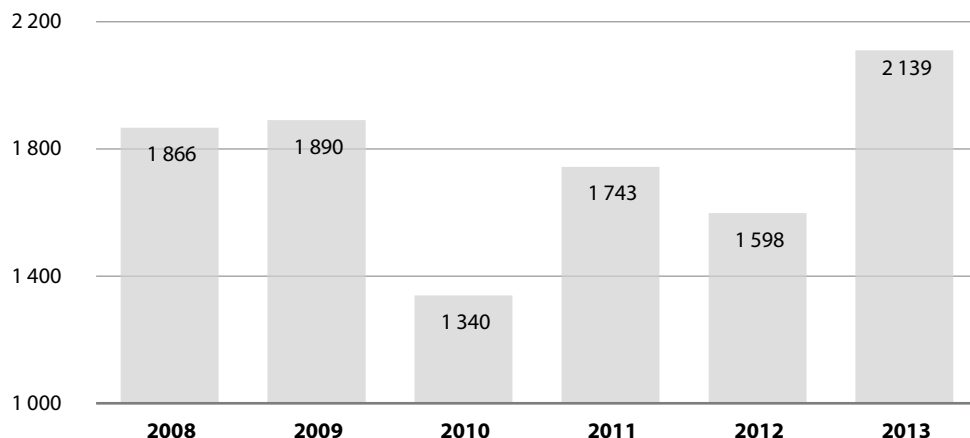
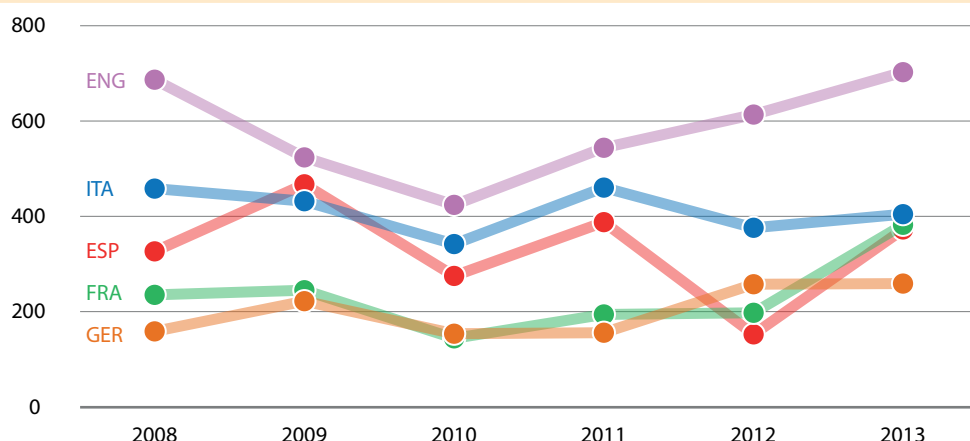

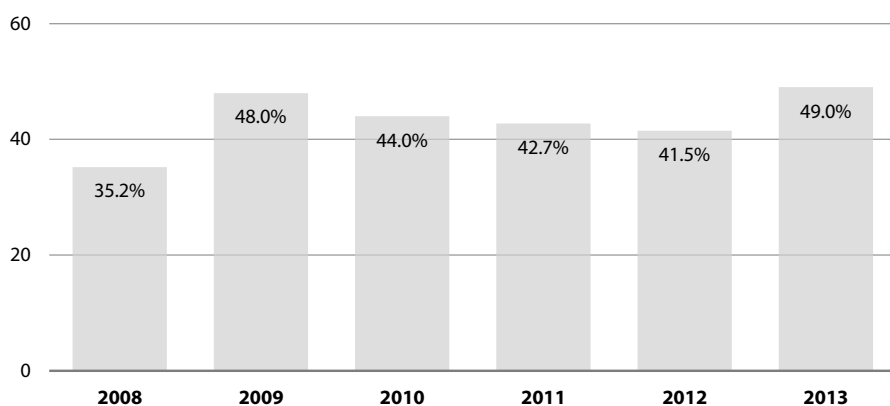
➤ Transfer expenditure of big-5 league clubs* (million euro, summer transfer window)

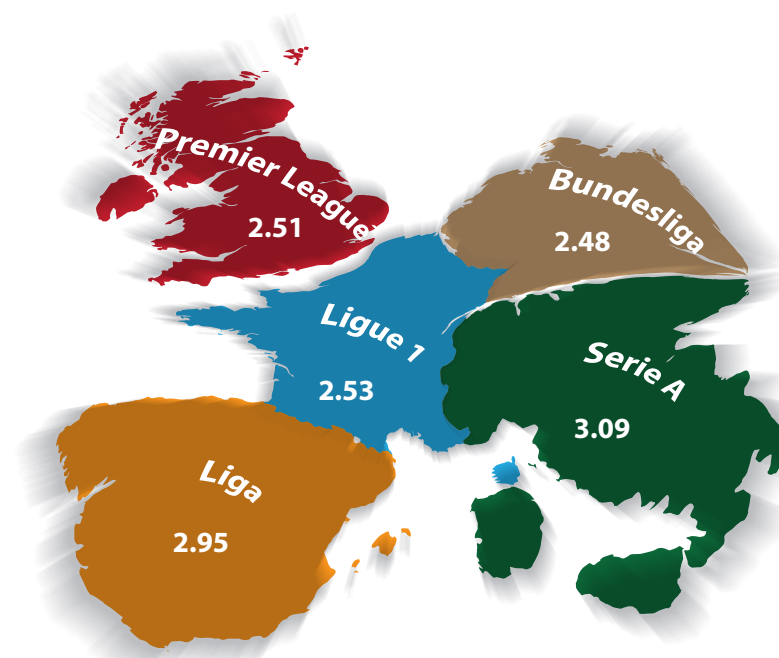

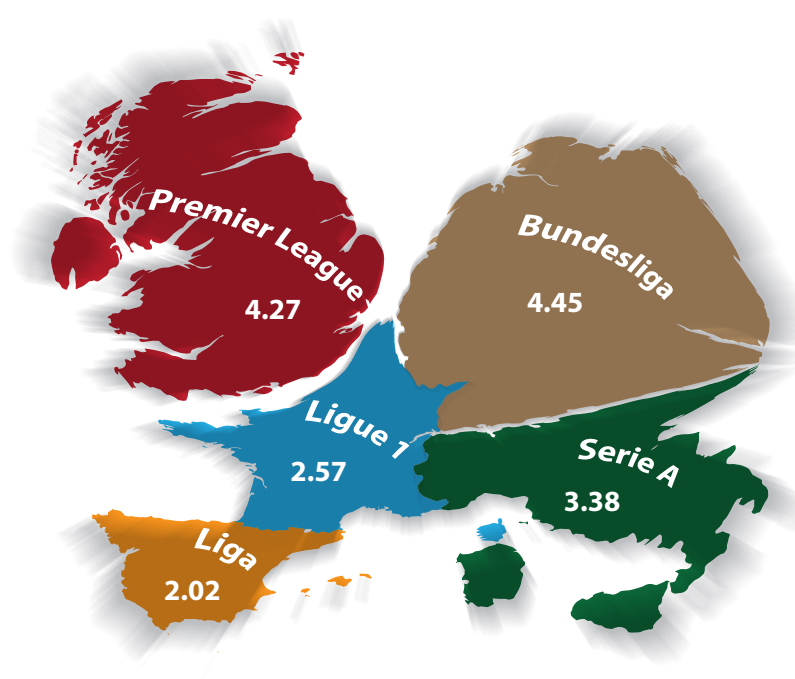

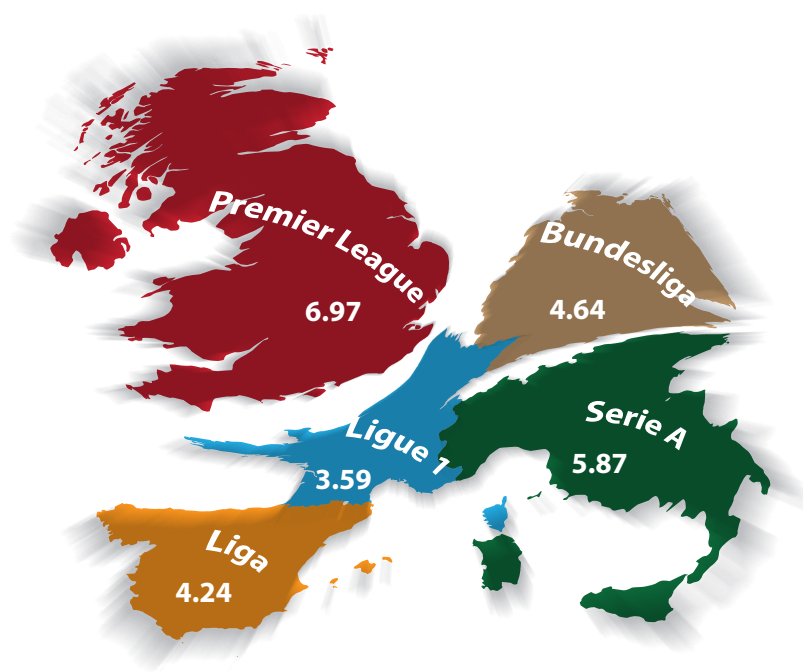

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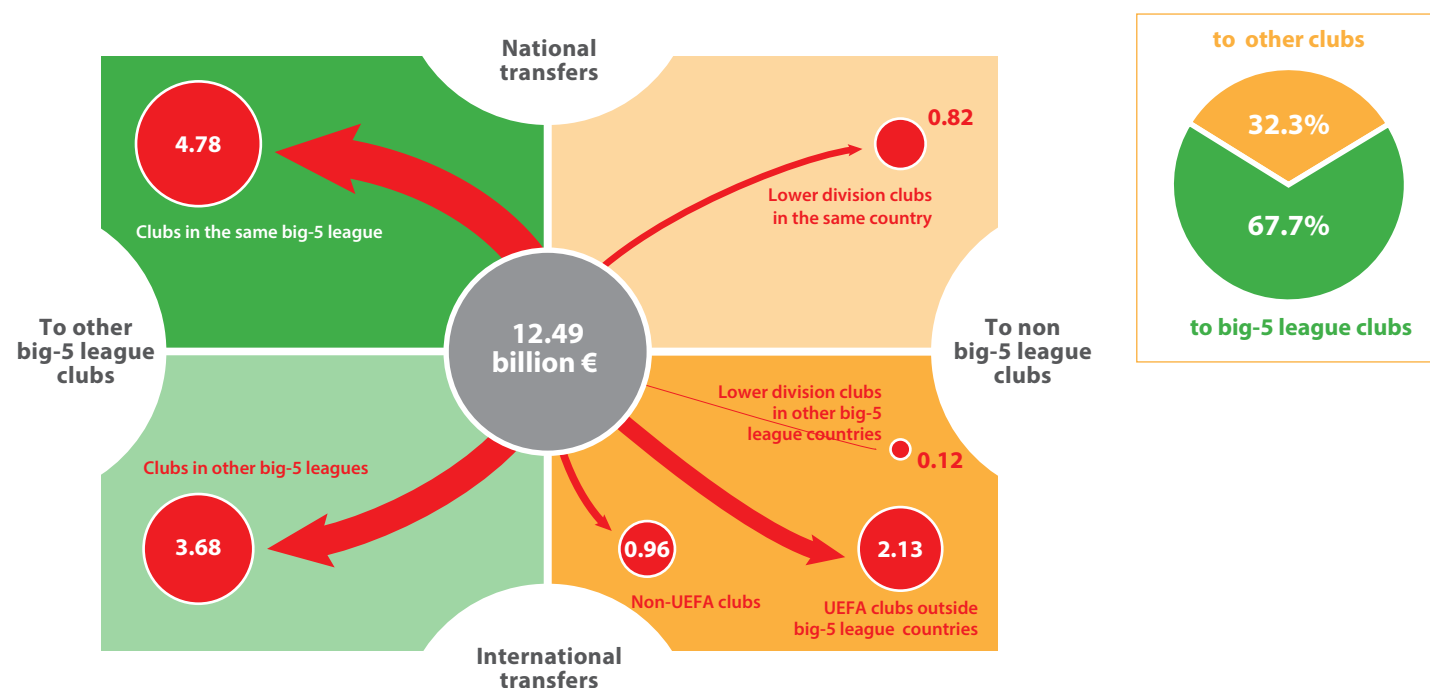

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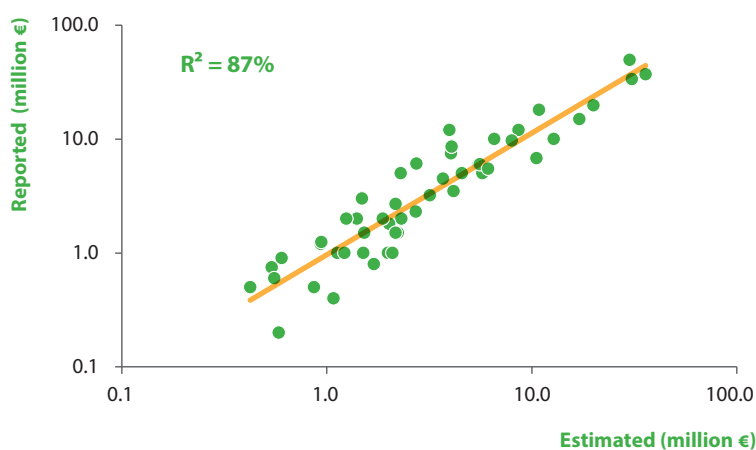
